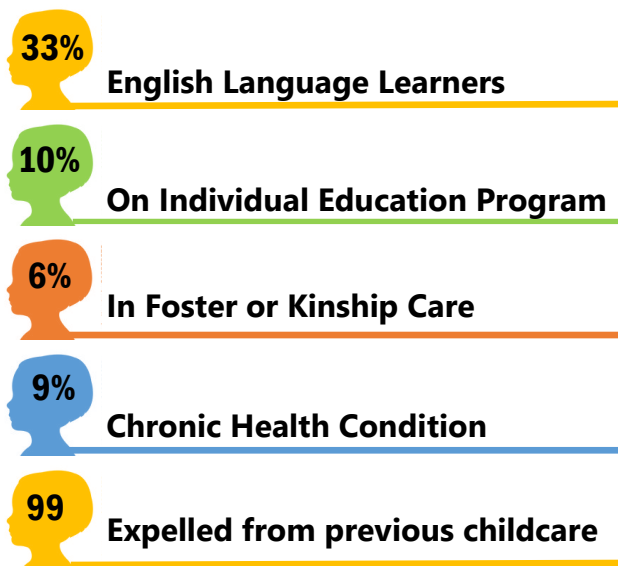


ECEAP FOCUS ON . . .

The mission of the Early Childhood Education & Assistance Program is to work with children and families to ensure that they are ready to succeed and thrive in school and life. Since the program is not fully funded, ECEAP prioritizes children at highest risk of school failure, using income and risk factors that have been linked by research to school performance.

Who are ECEAP Kids?



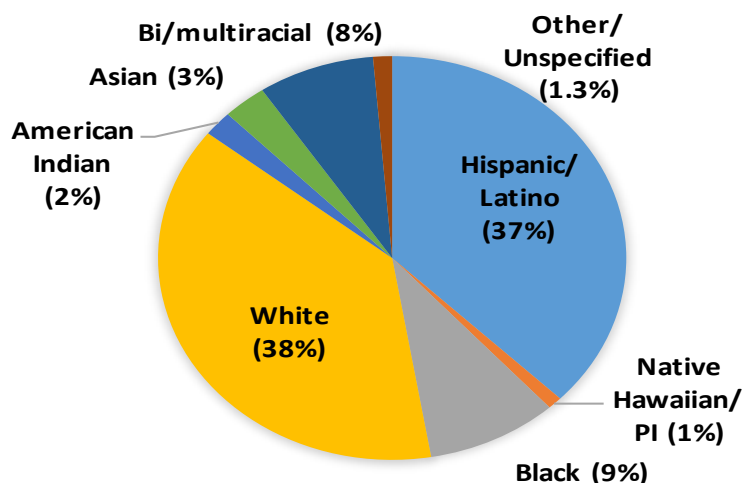
As a Result of ECEAP . . .

- ✓ 311 received **vision or hearing** care
- ✓ 34% got caught up on **well-child exams**
- ✓ 27% got caught up on **immunizations**
- ✓ 510 received **mental health** consultation
- ✓ 674 received **dental treatment**

2017-19 ***ECEAP Expansion***

ECEAP is Washington's best strategy for better school and life outcomes. To ensure our children aren't left behind, we need three things this year:

- ◆ Funding for **2708 new children** in full & extended day classrooms
- ◆ **16.7% increase in the per-child rate** so programs can recruit and retain staff and meet high quality standards
- ◆ **\$26 million for a facilities bond fund** to enable programs to expand and reach more children.
